## North Talladega County Leadership Program

The Greater Talladega Area Chamber of Commerce will launch its North Talladega County Leadership Program on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> of September with an orientation and team-building session at the Heritage Trail Conference Center in Fayetteville. There will be another class in September on the 16<sup>th</sup> and, thereafter, the class will meet the first Wednesday of every month through May 2011. Classes focus on City/County Government, Education, Economic Development, Healthcare/Non-profits, Lincoln/Munford, State Government, Law Enforcement/Judicial, and Quality of Life. 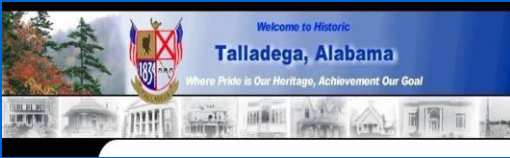
